During the Fall semester, **68%** of students were enrolled in undergraduate academic degree programs, **27%** were in graduate degree programs, and **1%** was enrolled in certificate programs. **53%** of students were enrolled as majors in the School of Nursing; **18%** in the School of Arts and Sciences, and **29%** in the School of Health Professions (this includes enrollment in non-degree programs).
