

**FRANCISICAN MISSIONARIES OF OUR LADY UNIVERSITY
STATISTICAL PROFILE**
Calendar Year 2018

- **Programs Offered** – Programs available for students admitted for enrollment included: 2 doctoral, 4 master's, 9 baccalaureate, and 3 associate-level degree programs. Additionally, 1 non-degree/certificate program was offered.
- **Student Enrollment** – 1330 Spring (83% female, 17% male); 650 Summer (80% female, 20% male); 1362 Fall (80% female, 20% male).
- **Credit Hours** – FranU generated 32,441 student credit hours in 2018 (13,646 in spring; 4140 in summer; 14655 in fall).
- **Program Enrollment** – During the fall semester, 82% of students were enrolled in undergraduate academic degree programs, 17% were in graduate degree programs, and 1% was enrolled in technical programs. 59% of students were enrolled as majors in the School of Nursing; 14% in the School of Arts and Sciences and 26% in the School of Health Professions (this includes enrollment in non-degree programs).
- **Age Characteristics** – The average age of FranU students is 28. Seventy-two percent of the student body is under 30 years of age, and 10% is over 40 years of age.
- **Ethnicity Characteristics** – 26.4% of those attending FranU self-identify as U.S. Students of Color: 14.8% Black or African American; 2.9% Asian; 7.6% Hispanic; .4% Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander; and .7% American Indian/Alaska Native.
- **Geographic Distribution** – 65.9% of the student body lists their parish of residence as East Baton Rouge (39.4%) or a parish within a 75-mile radius, primarily Ascension, Livingston, Tangipahoa or Lafayette. In the fall of 2018, 7.6% of students were from states other than Louisiana.
- **Degrees Conferred** – FranU awarded academic degrees in 2018. Following the spring semester, 153 degrees were awarded (29.4% associate; 50.3% baccalaureate; 20.2% masters). Completion of the summer term led to 11 additional degree conferrals (63.6% baccalaureate, 36.4% masters). Completion of the fall semester led to 143 additional degree conferrals (0.7% associate, 63.6% baccalaureate, 18.9% masters, 16.8% doctoral).
- **Faculty** – FranU employed 83 full-time faculty members (both 10-month and 12-month contract), laboratory instructors/coordinators, and draws as needed from a pool of well qualified professionals who serve as adjunct faculty.
- **Staff** – FranU constituencies are served by 86 professional and support staff members in enrollment services, academic affairs, counseling, financial aid, business affairs, development, institutional effectiveness, library, technology, and administrative support positions including extra duty Baton Rouge police officers and non-work study student workers. This also includes Deans.
- **Budget** – FranU's operating budget for Fiscal Year 2018 was \$22,218,675.
- **Physical Plant** – The University occupied twelve buildings near Our Lady of the Lake Regional Medical Center in South Baton Rouge.
