The University occupies twelve buildings near Our Lady of the Lake Regional Medical Center in South Baton Rouge.

During the Fall semester, **70%** of students were enrolled in undergraduate academic degree programs, **29%** were in graduate degree programs, and **1%** was enrolled in certificate programs. **52%** of students were enrolled as majors in the School of Nursing; **15%** in the School of Arts and Sciences, and **33%** in the School of Health Professions (this includes enrollment in non-degree programs).
