Four DPT Faculty Receive Endowed Professorships

Over \$180,000 awarded for faculty research

FranU DPT faculty members Dr. Jaime Caillet, Dr. Michael Ludwig, Dr. Jeffrey Thompson, and Dr. Phil Page were awarded over \$180,000 in research funding through the Louisiana Board of Regents Endowed Professorships Program. The funding will go toward research on integrating musculoskeletal ultrasound into the DPT curriculum as well as equipment for biomechanical analysis and virtual reality anatomy education.

It's Scholarly Project Season

DPT students have access state of the art equipment

Students at FranU DPT are required to complete a scholarly project for graduation. Similar to a thesis or dissertation, their scholarly projects are full-length manuscripts that answer a research question. Students can choose to complete a systematic literature review, survey, or an observational pilot study for their project. Those choosing observational studies have access to the latest research equipment for evaluating biomechanical and cardiopulmonary measures.
