FranU DPT Leads State Physical Therapy Research

The fall meeting of the state physical therapy association (APTA-LA) was held in August in Baton Rouge. FranU DPT Research Director Dr. Phil Page hosted the Research Symposium, where a record 24 presentations were made. Among the research were 13 presentations from FranU DPT students, faculty and alumni. In addition, 3 of the 4 research awards were presented to FranU research:

- **Jeff Thompson** (Best Platform Presentation) Reliability of cervical disc height measurements using musculoskeletal ultrasound.
- **Jaime Caillet** (Best Poster Presentation) Measurement of empathy in a Doctor of Physical Therapy program.
- **Saya Menzies** (Best Student Presentation) Description of the physical therapy workforce in Louisiana.

Others presenting their research were DPT students Danielle Rankin, Bailie Marsh; DPT alumni Kullen Mancil, William Foret, Matthew Clark, Azah Ayala, Kheri LeDay; and faculty Phil Page, Kirk Nelson, and Mari Kantrow.

Integrating Technology in Physical Therapy

In September, faculty member Dr. Jaime Caillet participated in an ultrasound-guided dry-needling workshop in Atlanta, Georgia. This 27-hour course allowed clinicians to examine specific tissues for a more individualized treatment approach related to their condition. FranU continues to be at the forefront of innovation and teaching technologies, supporting integration of musculoskeletal ultrasound as an entry-level skill into future coursework.

Orthopedic Summit Research

The Orthopedic Summit for Evolving Techniques (OSET) was held in Boston in September. FranU DPT Research Director Dr. Phil Page served as chair of the Research Symposium, where 5 research posters were presented by students, faculty and alumni. The abstracts were printed in the [October 2022 issue of the *International Journal of Sports Physical Therapy*](#). In addition, Dr. Page had 2 session presentations on rehabilitation and technology. OSET, now in its 12th year, is the premier gathering of over 1,000 orthopaedic surgeons and musculoskeletal specialists in subspecialties, including knee, hip, shoulder, elbow, spine, trauma, foot & ankle and sports rehabilitation.
