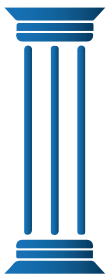

is a unique opportunity for rising juniors and seniors in high school to build community upon the foundation of their faith while cultivating the seed that Christ has planted within each one of them.

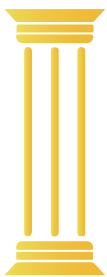
Around 30 high school students are invited for a six-day, overnight summer immersion experience guided by faculty, staff and students of Franciscan Missionaries of Our Lady University.

THE PILLARS OF THE SUMMER



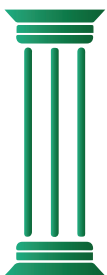
FAITH

Young people set a foundation of the Christian life through an **encounter** with Christ through the Sacraments, the rich Catholic tradition and personal prayer.



THEOLOGY

Young people use faith and reason to fuel a **passion** and **commitment** to be witnesses of Christ. Our renowned theology professors at FranU teach what we believe, why we believe it and how it makes a difference.



SERVICE

Young people experience the importance of service, particularly to the poor and marginalized, when discerning their personal vocation. Simultaneously, they reflect on the importance of **relationships** with those they serve and the **dignity of life**.



We wish to build a culture of vocation. This is a culture where each person strives to channel their lives to the pursuit of holiness - all things that are objectively good, beautiful and true. A flourishing life can only come about by holistic formation of the person through an integrative approach using works of mercy, intellectual formation, and spiritual development. This ultimately helps the participants discover their personal call from God.

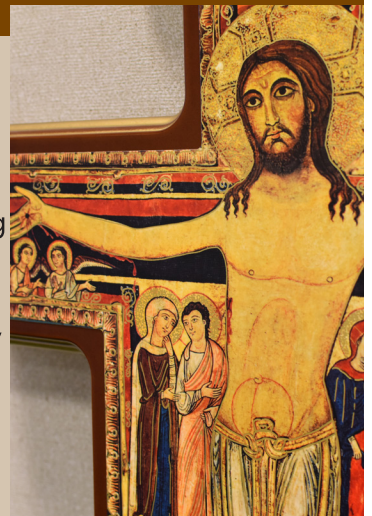

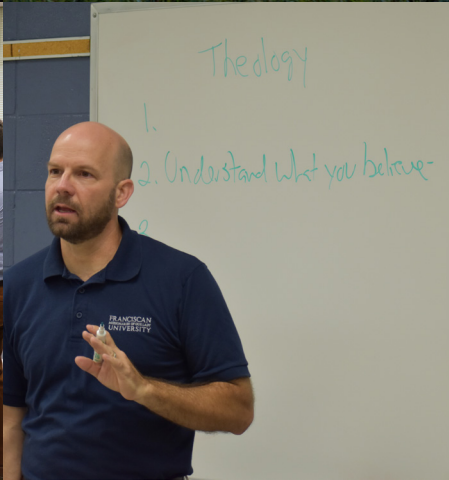
WHY ST. FRANCIS?

St. Francis of Assisi is the patron saint of FranU and we aim to support our University's mission to educate and form Franciscan servant leaders. Furthermore, St. Francis serves as a model of a deeply rooted servant of Christ devoted to living the gospel, serving the poor, and surrendering to Jesus Christ, thereby providing us with an inspiration for our mission of forming missionary disciples.

We also adopt other Franciscan saints to intercede for us, including St. Clare of Assisi and St. Padre Pio.

WHAT IS THE EXPERIENCE? • • • • •

Every morning a theology lecture is provided by our renowned FranU theology professors. This is just one area of the week that makes TFE a unique experience. The lectures encompass the themes of identity, morality, and encountering Jesus in the Eucharist. These lectures set the foundation for each day.

Participants engage with the Catholic faith through daily Mass, the Sacraments, reciting Morning and Evening Prayer together, and reflecting on their experiences through conversations with their peers. Mentors accompany them during personal prayer and study in the evening as they discern how the Spirit is moving within them and develop their prayer lives.

Each day we serve our community with a specific emphasis on the poor and marginalized. We are thankful for the community partnerships, such as the local St. Vincent de Paul Campus. Participants perform service while also witnessing the dignity of each human person by encountering those they serve in a special way.

We like to have a little bit of fun! Our college team enjoys organizing experiences like our TFE Olympics and FranU simulation hospital escape rooms, among other things.

Each afternoon is catered to different experiences related to the development of one's vocation and prayer life. Participants hear from guest speakers from our community and also watch a documentary of Franciscan friars living their call to a radical life, all the while being encouraged to encounter Christ in a true and real way. They also visit FranU to learn more about our university!
